Since 2015, he is the deputy director for strategy, surveys and statistics at the French public national sickness fund (CNAM, a mandatory fund covering more than 75 % of the French population). He coordinates the writing of the annual strategic reports and oversees CNAM's contribution to a national fund to support and spread organizational innovations.
